THE TENTS

WHAT ACTIVITIES CAN I BOOK MYSELF?

You're welcome to book your own activities but you must check these with us before you book with an external provider. We need to notify the landowner of any activities and other suppliers on site before arrival. If an activity is not checked with us first, this could incur a charge from the damage deposit.

Please note, hot tubs are not permitted due to the damage they do to the land but there are day spa's nearby.

DJ's, live music and butler in the buff are also not permitted.

Confetti canons, smoke bombs, sparklers and Chinese/sky lanterns are not permitted. Only biodegradable glitter is allowed on site.

WHAT IS THERE TO DO NEARBY?

Bramhope is a beautiful area of Leeds with lots to do in the area. You can also travel easily by car to some great places in North Yorkshire for a day trip before returning to the site for your evening activities. We've listed them all out here with website links for you to look through:

- The Fox And Hounds Pub with restaurant and bar. 1-mile walk from site.
- <u>Crag House Farm</u> Restaurant and Tea Rooms. Excellent for afternoon tea!
- <u>Chevin Country Park Hotel and Spa</u> Day spa and treatments
- Leeds city centre with nightlife, culture and shopping (20 minute drive)
- Nearby market towns Otley (9 minute drive), Ilkley (21 minute drive) and Knaresborough (28 minute drive)
- <u>The Turkish Baths</u> in the spa town of Harrogate (26 minute drive)
- <u>Harewood House</u> Country house with grounds and gardens
- <u>Otley Chevin Forest Park</u> Beautiful woodland walk with views of Otley

If you'd like to check in earlier or later just let us know and we'll do our best to accommodate.


WHERE IS THE SITE?

Access to the site is through St Helena's Camping and Caravan Park at LS18 5HZ. Birds and Bells Glamping Glade is a private area adjacent to the park.

Birds and Bells Glamping Glade is situated in an exclusive use area. The entrance is shared with our Birds and Bells Festival Field area and there are four parking spaces.



The two areas (Festival Field and Glamping Glade) are separated by a fence and tree line but you may hear noise from the group in the other area and vice versa.

WHAT WILL YOU NEED TO BRING?

- Towels
- Toiletries we do provide shower gel but you may want to bring extras
- Torches
- Extra layers (jumpers, socks etc)
- Wellies and waterproofs if the weather is wet
- Sun cream if it's hot
- Hot water bottles if it's forecast to be cold
- Earplugs If you're a light sleeper then it's best to bring these as there are farm animals and occasional planes flying over
- Flip flops/slip on shoes for those middle of the night loo trips!
