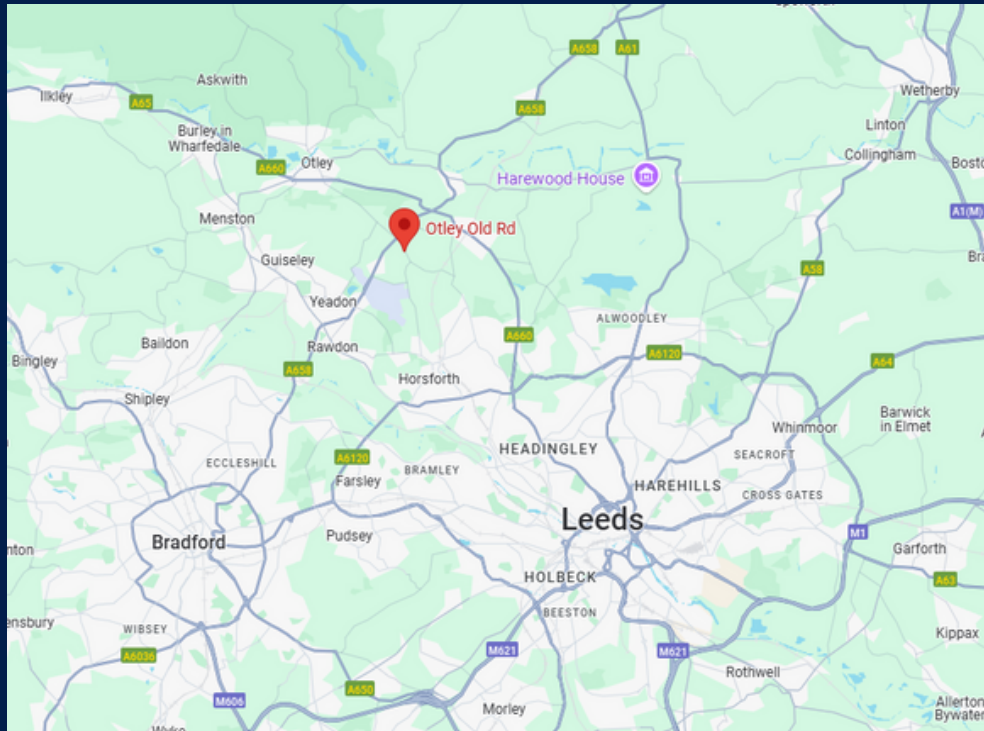


WHAT'S INCLUDED ALREADY?

- **Exclusive access** to a private clearing from **Friday 12pm to Sunday 5pm.**
- **Luxury Bell Tents** sleeping 12 people (additional tents can be pitched for more guests – subject to availability)
- **Yurt for Gathering** with tables, benches, dry hire bar, fairy lights, disco ball and decorations
- **Glamp Fire** with Seating, firepit, fuel and marshmallows for toasting
- **Silent Disco** all weekend with tablet and pre-loaded playlists
- **Board Games**
- Exclusive Use **Toilets and Showers**
- 'The Hut' a wash up area with **fridge, sink, lights and plug sockets**
- **Gas BBQ** (with gas included) and BBQ utensils
- **Hot Drinks** – including Tea, Coffee, Hot Chocolate (just bring your own milk)
- **Bunting & Solar Lights** around the site

WHERE IS THE SITE?



Access to the site is through
St Helena's Camping and
Caravan Park at **LS18 5HZ**.



The **Glamping Glade** is a private, exclusive area adjacent to the park.

It shares an entrance with the Festival Field.

There are four allocated parking spaces for the Glamping Glade.

The two areas (Festival Field and Glamping Glade) are separated by a fence and tree line but you may hear noise from the group in the other area and vice versa.

The areas are shown on the map here:



WHEN IS CHECK IN/CHECK OUT?

Check in is anytime from 12pm on the Friday.

We ask that you check out by 5pm on the Sunday.

If you'd like to check in earlier or later just let us know and we'll do our best to accommodate.



We won't be on site during your stay but we are available on the phone during the whole weekend should you have any questions.

WHAT ACTIVITIES CAN WE DO ON SITE?

You're welcome to book activities with other suppliers but you must check these with us before you book with an external provider. We need to notify the landowner of any activities and other suppliers on site before arrival. If an activity is not checked with us first, this could incur a charge from the damage deposit.



Please note, hot tubs are not permitted due to the damage they do to the land but there are day spa's nearby. DJ's, live music and butler in the buff are not permitted. Confetti canons, smoke bombs, sparklers and Chinese/sky lanterns are not permitted. Only biodegradable glitter is allowed on site.



EXTRAS

To add to your weekend, we've compiled a list of extras for your group starting from **£3.75 per person.**

SPORTS DAY KIT - £45

Host your own old school sports day and see which team comes out on top!

Includes tug of war, egg and spoon, sack race, three legged race and relay batons. Medals and a flag for the winners photo!

LAWN GAMES - £45

Great for the lulls between activities and to get different friendship groups mixing. Includes giant jenga, limbo and croquet!

PICNIC SET HIRE -£80

For a boujie picnic, al fresco lunch or afternoon tea. Includes outdoor rugs, low tables, floor cushions, table runners, place mats, candles and candle holders, vases with dried flowers.



All extras are available on a first come first served basis and due to limited availability we take a 50% non-refundable deposit with the remaining balance due with the final payment 4 weeks before your stay. All extras will be in labelled boxes inside the yurt for when you arrive and you will be able to use them all weekend. Instruction manuals can be found inside the boxes. The Picnic Set-Up can be placed wherever you would like and we've included photo's of our set-up for you to re-create.

WHAT IS THERE TO DO NEARBY?

Bramhope is a beautiful area of Leeds with lots to do in the area. You can also travel easily by car to some great places in North Yorkshire for a day trip before returning to the site for your evening activities. We've listed them all out here with website links for you to look through:

- The Fox And Hounds – Pub with restaurant and bar. 1-mile walk from site.
- Crag House Farm – Restaurant and Tea Rooms. Excellent for afternoon tea!
- Chevin Country Park Hotel and Spa – Day spa and treatments
- Leeds city centre with nightlife, culture and shopping (20 minute drive)
- Nearby market towns - Otley (9 minute drive), Ilkley (21 minute drive) and Knaresborough (28 minute drive)
- The Turkish Baths in the spa town of Harrogate (26 minute drive)
- Harewood House – Country house with grounds and gardens
- Otley Chevin Forest Park – Beautiful woodland walk with views of Otley

For brunch in Leeds City Centre (around 25 minutes drive) we recommend:
The Lost and Found (Albion Street)
Fleur (Bottomless Brunch)
Fibre (Drag Brunch)

OTHER QUESTIONS

What food can we make or get delivered to site?

There is a 6 burner Gas BBQ with gas included and groups often get local takeaways delivered. You can also get pizza/food vans to the site or hire a BBQ chef if you don't want to cook yourselves! Leeds City Centre is also only 20 minutes away by car with lots of restaurants available.

Can I decorate the site?

Yes, the yurt includes coloured orb decorations hanging from the roof, fairy lights and a disco ball. There are lots of coloured ribbons and bunting around the site too so you shouldn't need to add much more. See our blog [here](#) for some decoration inspiration.

Do we need to bring our own bedding?

No, this is all included for you. Each bed has a 13.5 tog duvet, pillow, duvert cover, pillowcase and blanket.

Is there electric on site?

Yes, there are plugs in the main yurt for you to charge phones and use hairdryers/straighteners.
